

Membership Cambridge and District Photographic Society

Notes on sources

This document contains names of those known to have been connected with the Cambridge and District Photographic Society from its inception to the start of WW2. Names have been taken from a Society Membership Book deposited in the Cambridgeshire Collection. The names from this book have been supplemented by names found in the Society's minute books, also deposited in the Cambridgeshire Collection. In this document for each letter of the alphabet, names are presented in two alphabetical series – first those in the membership book, then those from the minutes and a few other sources, including local newspapers.

Unfortunately there are some gaps in the list as there was a period when the minutes do not record the names of proposed new members. There is also a 7 year gap in the minutes. We have hopefully recorded 75 per cent plus of the membership, and have certainly included those most actively involved with the running of the Society during this period.

General Notes on the Society's Membership Book.

- The Membership book is an alphabetical index manuscript book. Members were added as they joined, crossed out as they left.
- The page is missing for all the members whose surname begins with the letter "A".
- The book may be the Society's initial membership book from 1902. It has entries up to as late as 1917. In most cases names added from around 1913 include the names of their proposer and a date of proposal - shown in brackets in the list below.
- Many (153) of the total (281) entries are crossed out to show membership ceased at some time between 1902 and 1917. The crossed-out entries are marked below with an asterisk. This left 128 apparently live memberships at around 1917.
- Membership was reported to be 92 in July 1904 (Cambridge Independent Press 1 July 1904 p8)
- An attempt had been made by the keepers of the membership book to show the impact of WW1 on the club and its members by adding information about enlisting and serving in the armed forces – this is also shown below.
- Some 51 of the total 281 membership book entries appear to relate to university students or members of the University
- Additional material added from other sources is shown in [square brackets]
- The occasional inaccuracy in some names has been corrected using later information in [square brackets]. Names, especially initials, are very difficult to interpret in the original manuscript.
- Some names appear twice, suggesting leaving and then re-joining
- Other sources used include Spalding's Cambridge Directories and Alphabetical Indices to the Cambridge Tripos Results
- From 1917 there are new members proposed whose names do not appear in the membership book.

Notes on the minute books.

The Cambridgeshire Collection holds minute books from the Society in six volumes covering the periods 1913 to 1927 and 1934 to 1946. There is also a Council minute book from 1934 to 1945 and a visitors' signature book 1930 to 1935. These are all filed under reference C.65.5 (Overflow).

The minutes are all hand written and in places are difficult to interpret. Especially difficult are the initials of members, and in places there will almost certainly be transcription errors.

A - Names in the Membership Book

Although no names starting with the letter "A" are listed because the page is missing, we can conjecture that CS Addison (Organising Committee of the 1902 Photographic Convention of Great Britain) would have been listed as one of the founder members. Rev EG Alderson who gave a number of lectures to the society, was probably another early member.
